

Student Refund Procedures

Seniors and Students leaving Cherry Creek School District

Refunds **up to** \$5.00 may be given at elementary schools and refunds up to \$10.00 may be given at secondary schools. Students should request to speak with the kitchen manager to process their refund.

Refunds **over** \$5.00 at elementary schools and refunds **over** \$10.00 at secondary schools must be forwarded to the student nutrition center for payment via check. Students transferring within the Cherry Creek school District

If students are planning to transfer to another school within the Cherry Creek School District, their meal account balance will be automatically transferred to the Cherry Creek School that they will attend next school year.

Returning Students

At the end of the school year, all remaining student meal account balances will be carried over to the start of the next school year.

Information for Elementary and Middle Schools ONLY
